

Please read these instructions completely and carefully before applying this product. Correct application is important for proper function of the brace.

Indications: Soft tissue injuries of the lower leg, acute ankle sprains, stress fractures of the lower leg, stable fractures of the foot and ankle, stable delayed union or non-union fractures of distal tibia and fibula, achilles tendon repairs.

Application Instructions:



- 1. Unfasten straps, remove front panel and open liner.
- While seated, place leg in brace and position heel at the back of the brace. Wrap liner around the leg and foot and secure.
- 3. Replace the front panel.
- 4. Fasten the straps from the bottom to the top.
- For additional control of the ankle, use the alternate location strap shown in Fig. (A).
- Adjust air bladder compression by pushing the bulbs on either side of the boot. To deflate the air bladders, open the cap of the smaller button next to the bulbs and push the button to release air.

Use and Care:

Hand wash the liner with mild soap & water & lay out to dry. Do NOT machine dry.
